Gear transport

We offer a service where we transport your gear to the rally site from Dunedin and bring it back after the rally. Drop your gear to the OMCC clubrooms at 3 Clark Street, Dunedin between 6-7pm on Friday 4th June. You can pick your gear up when the truck arrives at the rally site. The cost is \$5 per bag, each way.

To have your gear brought back, bring it to the stage area on Sunday morning. Your gear will be available for collection from the clubrooms on Monday and Tuesday evening after the rally between 7-8pm.

Gear shuttle service available to take gear from the rally carpark to your campsite.

The Dunstan Trail

The Dunstan Trail is one of the most exciting ways to travel to the Brass Monkey Rally. Approximately 300 off road riders come this way each year to say they really have done the hard yards to get their badge.

However, please be warned—stick to the marked tracks, as anything off the trail is private property. So please ensure gates are left closed if that is the way you found them. Please do not damage fences and gates to get on the trail. It only takes a couple of people not sticking to the rules to spoil it for every one else.

Please also be considerate of others on the trail and keep left.

In addition, this part of the country can be very hazardous during the winter months, and unfortunately it is out of our control if the road has been closed. **THIS IS FOR YOUR SAFETY.** Rescue services may not be able to get to you or even find you. **The police also have grown intolerant of the number of unregistered and un-warranted motorcycles travelling from the end of the trail to the rally site. You have been warned.**
